Eileen Howard Dunn is vice president of corporate communications and community relations for CVS Corporation. Ms. Dunn is responsible for all public relations, employee communications and community relations for America's largest retail pharmacy.

Ms. Dunn has managed the internal and external communications strategy for CVS during a period of rapid company growth, including the 2004 acquisition of 1,260 Eckerd stores and most recently, the acquisition of more than 700 former Osco and Sav-on stores. These acquisitions added approximately 45,000 colleagues to the CVS organization, and today there are over 170,000 colleagues in more than 6,100 stores across 43 states.

Ms. Dunn oversees CVS's philanthropic efforts including the company's support of health, education, and community. Also under her purview is the CVS/Pharmacy Charitable Trust that supports health programs servicing children with disabilities and public schools that are expanding programs promoting the inclusion of children with disabilities.

Prior to joining CVS in 2004, Ms. Howard Dunn was a vice president responsible for external and internal communications, investor relations, and community relations for Office Depot.

While at General Mills, she has served in a cross-functional capacity as an assistant marketing manager for Yoplait's Strategic Growth Channels business. She also served as a lobbyist for General Mills at the state Legislature during a rotation through the General Mills' public affairs department. Prior to joining the General Mills Foundation in August of 1997, Ms. Luger practiced corporate law for 10 years.

Ms. Luger graduated from Wellesley College in 1983 and earned a BA with honors in political science and sociology. Ms. Luger also graduated magna cum laude and Phi Beta Kappa, served as president of College Government, and was a Minnesota finalist for a Rhodes Scholarship.
